James Emmett, M.S., is a national leader in development of employment services for persons with autism spectrum disorders as well as in assisting corporations in creation of outreach efforts to the disability and autism communities. He currently serves as the Chief Operating Officer of Integrated Behavioral Systems and is a Partner in the consulting firm Two Steps Forward. James graduated with a Master's Degree in Rehabilitation Counseling from Illinois Institute of Technology. He recently completed 1.5 years working as the Disability Program Manager for Walgreens helping set up the company's national disability initiative (www.walgreensoutreach.com), and also assisted Easter Seals National in laying the foundation for their national autism services network.

The number of individuals with autism spectrum disorders moving into the workforce is skyrocketing. High schools, transition programs, and community rehabilitation providers are facing the challenge of providing quality educational and job training services to a rapidly growing number of students with autism spectrum disorders.
